Unfortunately, many in our community do not live in a house that is comfortable or safe. At **Livingston County Habitat for Humanity** we build houses that are safe, efficient and affordable for families that could otherwise not afford one.

To date, **Livingston County Habitat for Humanity** has built or refurbished **17 houses** in our county. That's over **\$1 million** added to the tax base. But more importantly, it means our partner families can live and raise their families in safe housing. We are presently building house number 18 in Scottsburg and are looking for land parcels for our future projects.

“A house can be called a home when an individual or a group of people has an emotional attachment to it.” This begins with our partner families helping to build their house along with our volunteers. Performing their Sweat Equity requirement builds pride of ownership. This transition from a house to a home really takes hold when a family moves in and begins to prosper with their family. A very satisfying feeling for all involved.
